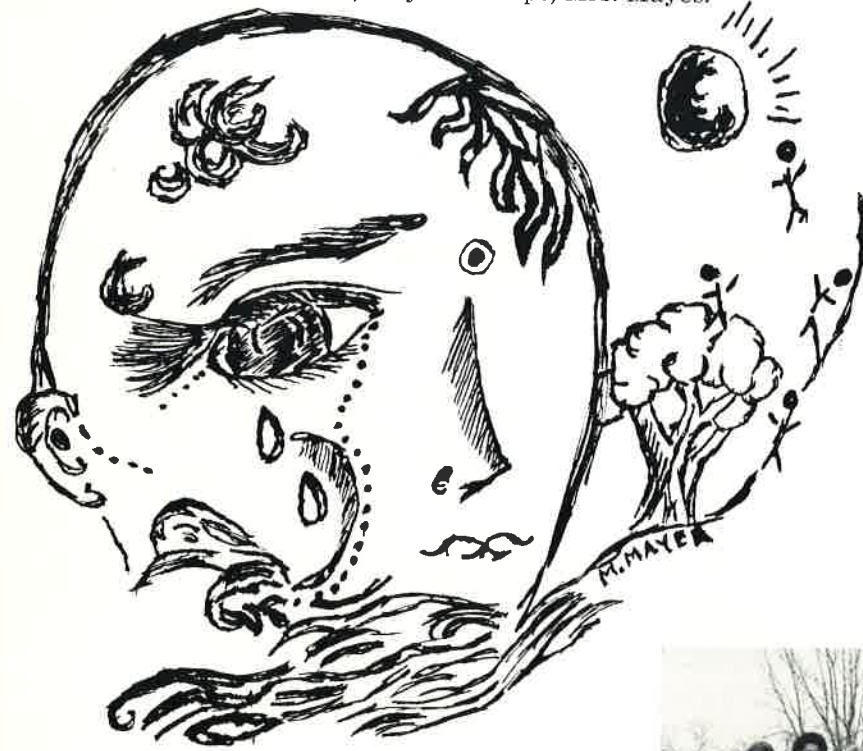


YOUTH

cherry-faced children?

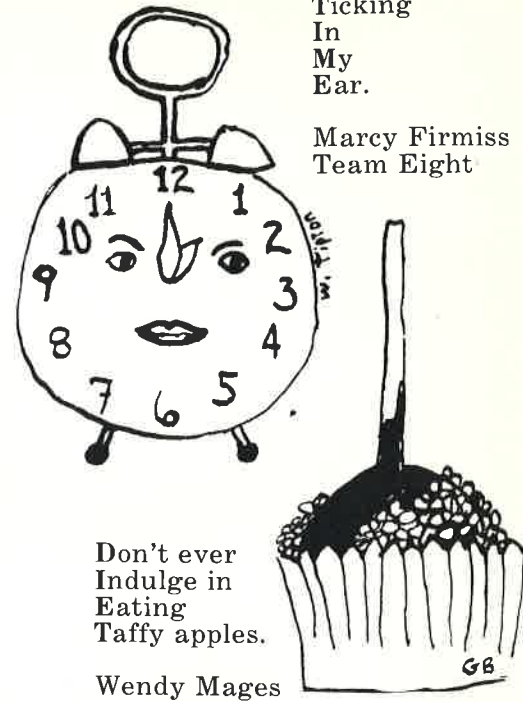

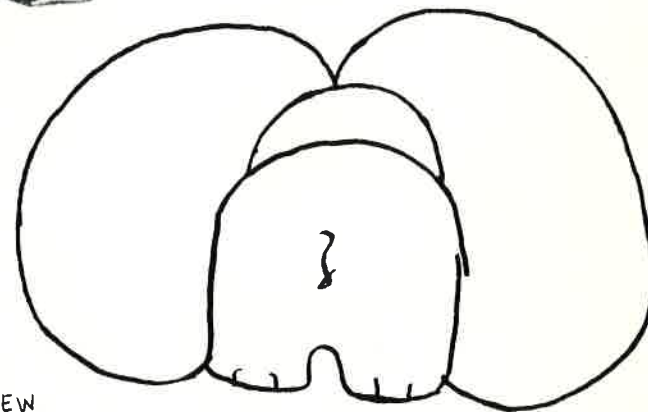
THE HOUSE
